- Level wheelchair access to museum via Sunday School
- Internal ramp to chapel
- Level access to other rooms via door by tea room

Toilets:

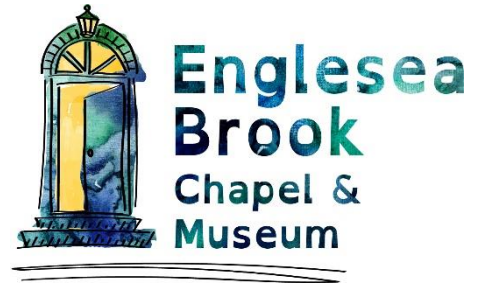
- **1 toilet plus 1 accessible toilet**
