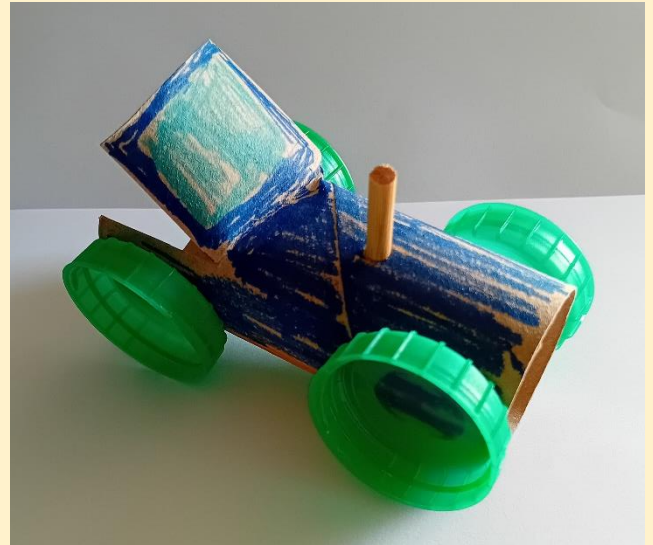


# Junk Tractor

You can make a tractor out of junk to remind you of all the important work farmers do.

- Use a loo roll tube for the body of the tractor.
- Ask a grown-up to help you cut a windscreen and bend it upwards at one end of the tube.
- You can colour your tractor anyway you wish.
- Glue on bottle tops to make wheels and push a piece of dowelling or a paper straw into the top of the tractor to make the exhaust.
