Walk the way of peace!

The Primitive Methodist Church was also known as the 'Peace Church'. Primitive Methodism urged people to find peaceful ways to settle conflict. Many Primitive Methodists refused to fight in World War 1 and were known as Conscientious Objectors.

You can make a peace sandal to remember all those who walk for peace and walk to share God's story.



- Draw around your foot on stiff card or a foam sheet.
- Carefully cut around the foot shape.
- Thread a needle with yarn or ribbon (you may need to ask a grown-up for help) and carefully push the needle between the toes, threading beads on the yarn. You can use as much yarn as you like.
- If you like, you can draw patterns on your sandal to make it extra-special.
- Can you find out how to write 'peace' in lots of different languages? Perhaps you could write them onto your peace sandal.
