

# Prayer Pot

The Primitive Methodists prayed at all times and in all places!

Prayer is the word we use to describe how we talk to God.

We can talk to God about anything, at any time and in any place.

We can ask for his help, and for things we need. We can tell him we love him. We can say sorry to him

when we have made a mistake. We can talk to him about other people who may need help.

We don't even have to use words – God will understand what we need to tell him.

God is always listening.

To help us to pray we can use the Bible or prayer books.

But why not make a prayer pot?

- Decorate a clear yoghurt pot or jar with jewels and stickers.
- Thread a wooden heart or name label onto a length of twine and tie it around the neck of the pot.
- Write the things you feel are important to pray about every day onto lolly sticks or card and place them in the jar.
- Now you can remember each day to talk to God!
